

## **APPEALS PANEL.**

Minutes of meeting in County Buildings, Wellington Square, Ayr,  
on 9th June 2010 at 2.30 p.m.

Present: Councillors John Allan (Chair), Brian Connolly and Sandra Goldie.

Apologies: Councillors John Hampton, Mike Peddie and Winifred Sloan.

### **1. Exclusion of Press and Public.**

The Panel resolved, in terms of Section 50(A)(4) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973, that the press and public be excluded for the following item of business on the agenda, on the grounds that it involved the likely disclosure of exempt information in terms of paragraph 1 of Part 1 of Schedule 7(A) of the Act.

### **2. Appeal Against Dismissal.**

The appellant, a former employee of the Directorate of Development and Environment, was in attendance and represented by W. Cooper, UNISON. J. Gribben, HR Manager, represented the Council.

The Panel heard both parties fully on the case, including evidence from the appellant and a witness called by the management representative and, after questions, both parties withdrew.

**Decided:** having heard and considered carefully all the documents and evidence presented, to unanimously agree that the grounds of appeal had been substantiated in part and, therefore, the appeal was upheld to the extent that the appellant would be reinstated under condition that the terms of the extended final written warning would remain in place for a further twelve months from this date.

Thereafter, both parties were re-admitted to the meeting and advised of the Panel's decision.
