

APPEALS PANEL.

1. Exclusion of Press and Public.

The Panel resolved, in terms of Section 50(A)(4) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973, that the press and public be excluded for the following item of business on the agenda, on the grounds that it involved the likely disclosure of exempt information in terms of paragraph 1 of Part 1 of Schedule 7(A) of the Act.

2. Grievance.

The appellant, an employee of the Directorate of Children and Community, was in attendance and represented by J. Winter. Unite. C. Douglas, HR Manager, represented the Council.

The Panel heard both parties fully on the case, including evidence from witnesses called by the Management representative and, after questions, both parties withdrew.

Decided: having heard and considered carefully all the documents and evidence presented, to unanimously agree that the grounds of grievance had been substantiated in part and the appeal was upheld in part.

Thereafter, both parties were re-admitted to the meeting and advised of the Panel's decision.
