**“11. Extended hours applications**

The Board may extend the licensed hours in respect of premises by such period as it considers appropriate. However, the Board will normally only do so in connection with

- A special event or occasion to be catered for exclusively on the premises or in a dedicated function suite
- A special event of local or national significance. The grant of an extension of licensed hours can last no longer than one month

Where the hours sought fall outwith the on-sales hours referred to in paragraph 7.2, the applicant will be required to demonstrate the hours requested are appropriate in the circumstances. The applicant should provide sufficient information to the Board to enable a decision to be made. This will include

- The hours sought
- The description of the special event or occasion
- The activities proposed
- The hours those activities will take place
- Why the event or occasion is considered to be special
- Why the event cannot take place within the existing on-sales hours.

Any applications for more than an hour beyond the core hours granted to premises will require to be considered at a Board hearing.”
