1. Introduction by the Chair.

There was submitted a report (issued) of February 2012 by the Executive Director - Development and Environment in respect of a planning application for the erection of 29 class 6 storage warehouses with associated access, infrastructure and landscaping at the Curragh, North of Grangestone Industrial Estate, Girvan.
