

APPEALS PANEL.

Minutes of meeting in County Buildings, Wellington Square, Ayr,
on 5th September 2017 at 2.00 p.m.

Present: Councillors Laura Brennan-Whitefield (Chair), Iain Campbell, Martin Dowey and Derek McCabe.

1. Exclusion of Press and Public.

The Panel resolved, in terms of Section 50(A)(4) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973, that the press and public be excluded for the following item of business on the agenda, on the grounds that it involved the likely disclosure of exempt information in terms of paragraph 1 of Part 1 of Schedule 7(A) of the Act.

2. Declarations of Interest.

There were no declarations of interest by Members of the Panel in terms of Standing Order No. 17 and the Councillors' Code of Conduct.

3. Minutes of previous meeting.

The minutes of 15th August and 23rd August 2017 (issued) were submitted and approved.

4. Grievance.

The appellant, an employee of the Economy, Neighbourhood and Environment Directorate, was in attendance and represented by W. Cooper, Unison. K. Dalrymple, Manager (Neighbourhood Services), represented the Council.

The Panel heard both parties fully on the case including three witnesses called by the Management side and, after questions, both parties withdrew.

Having heard and considered carefully all the documents and evidence presented, the Panel

Decided: unanimously, that the grounds for the grievance had not been substantiated and, therefore, the appeal was not upheld.

Thereafter, both parties were re-admitted to the meeting and advised of the Panel's decision.

The meeting ended at 3.50 p.m.
