2. It was noted that meetings were scheduled with regard to scrutiny of the funding provided by East Ayrshire Council and South Ayrshire Council for projects to be carried out by Strathclyde Passenger Transport (SPT).

### **AYRSHIRE ROADS ALLIANCE**

#### **UPDATE ON PERFORMANCE SCORECARD**

3. There was submitted a report dated 26 March 2018 (circulated) by the Head of Roads, Ayrshire Roads Alliance, which advised of the progress made to date against the Performance Scorecard.

Arising from discussion and in response to particular matters raised, Members received further information on:-

- negative publicity in relation to the scale of reported roads defects. Future performance scorecard updates would show, in addition to the number of defects reported, the number of repairs completed. Members recognised and supported the investment and work taking place to tackle reported defects; and
- the matrix for prioritising planned maintenance, factors informing it and the provision to review and update as required.

#### **RISK REPORT AND REGISTER**
