Minutes of meeting in County Buildings, Wellington Square, Ayr, on
1st November 2018 at 10.00 a.m.

1. Declarations of Interest.

There were no declarations of interest by Members of the Panel in terms of Council Standing Order No. 17 and the Councillors' Code of Conduct.

2. Minutes of previous meeting.

The minutes of the previous meetings of 15th August (Special) and 23rd August 2018 (issued) were submitted and approved.

3. Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 - Licences.**(a) Taxi Drivers.**

- (i) The Panel heard a representation from Police Scotland and from the applicant, Raza Sultan Hafiz in response.

Decided: to approve this application until 11th October 2020, subject to standard conditions as previously agreed.

Variation in Order of Business.

(b) **Private Hire Driver.**

The Panel heard a representation from Police Scotland and from the applicant, James Peter Jeffreys, in response.

Decided: to approve this application for three years, subject to standard conditions as previously agreed.

(c) **Private Hire Vehicle.**

The Panel considered the application from Mohamed Ali.

Decided: to continue consideration of this application to allow further information to be sought.

(d) **Street Trader.**

Aaron Westley McIndoe for Ice Cream Van at Belleisle Park, Rozelle Park and Grangemuir Road Car Park, Prestwick Seafront.

The Panel heard that the objection from Police Scotland had now been withdrawn.

Decided: to approve this application every day from 10.00 a.m. to 7.00 p.m. for the sale of hot and cold food and drinks (ice cream van) subject to standard conditions as previously agreed and subject to the applicant getting a concession from this authority to trade in these areas.

4. **Exclusion of press and public.**

The Panel resolved, in terms of Section 50A(4) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973, that the press and public be excluded from the remaining item of business on the agenda, on the grounds that it involved the likely disclosure of exempt information in terms of paragraph 6 of Part 1 of Schedule 7A of the Act.
