

SOUTH AYRSHIRE LICENSING BOARD.

Minutes of a meeting in the County Buildings, Ayr,
on 13 June 2019 at 10.00 a.m.

1. Declarations of Interest.

There were no declarations of interest by Members of the Board in terms of the Councillors' Code of Conduct.

2. Date of Next Board Meeting.

The Chair advised that the next Board meeting would be held in the County Hall, County Buildings, Ayr on Thursday, 15 August 2019 at 10.00 a.m.

3. Minutes of Previous Meeting.

The Minutes of the Meeting of South Ayrshire Licensing Board of 16 May 2019 (**issued**) were submitted.

Decided: to approve the Minutes of the previous meeting.

4. Revocation of Personal Licences.

There was submitted a report (**issued**) of 30 May 2019 by the Clerk to the Licensing Board advising of the revocation of personal licences.

Decided: to note the three licences revoked under delegated powers since the last report to the Board.

5. Personal Licence Renewals

The Depute Clerk to the Board advised

- (1) that the deadline for applications for Personal Licence Renewals for all licences granted on or before 1 September 2009 was 31 May 2019;
- (2) that 138 applications were not lodged by that date; and
- (3) that for those who had not renewed their licences, the only option would be for them to sit a one day training course and submit a new application.

6. Annual Functions and Financial Reports.

There was submitted a report ([tabled](#)) of 12 June 2019 by the Clerk to the Licensing Board advising of the requirement for an annual functions report as well as a financial report.

Decided: to approve the annual functions and financial report, as detailed in Appendix 1.

7. Update from Licensing Standards Officer.

The Licensing Standards Officer advised

- (1) that there had been a successful partnership event with Police Scotland on 29 May 2019 which was well attended by the local trade; and
- (2) that there had been recent visits to Members' Clubs with a training session being organised in the County Buildings, Ayr.

Decided: to note the position.

8. Correspondence from Police Scotland.

There was submitted a briefing paper from Police Scotland ([issued](#)) of 14 May 2019 providing a basis for constructive dialogue regarding terminal hours afforded to licensed premises based on South Ayrshire Licensing Board Policy.

Decided: to note that this item was withdrawn.

9. Correspondence from Fraser McIntyre, Director of Sprig Limited.

There was submitted a letter from Fraser McIntyre, Director of Sprig Limited ([issued](#)) requesting that the Board consider the current position regarding late night premises in South Ayrshire.

The Depute Clerk advised that Mr McIntyre did not participate in the consultation exercise regarding the Board's Licencing Policy, undertaken last year.

Decided: that this correspondence be considered at a Working Group that was to be set up to look further at the Council's Licensing Policy, with Mr. McIntyre and others being invited to participate in this Group.
